### **Guidance note on small numbers**

The Office for National Statistics (ONS) used a process called statistical disclosure control to ensure no individuals could be identified in any published 2011 Census tables. ONS swapped some Census records between different areas to protect information supplied by individuals. In practice, this means where a result is a small number, there is an uncertainty as to whether this is a true value.


## Age of usual residents

For 2011 Census purposes, a usual resident of the UK is anyone who, on census day, was in the UK and had stayed or intender to stay in the UK for a period of 12 months or more, or had a permanent UK address and was outside the UK and intended to be outside the UK for less than 12 months.










# Long term health problem or disability





- not in employment, but waiting to start a job already obtained and available.








