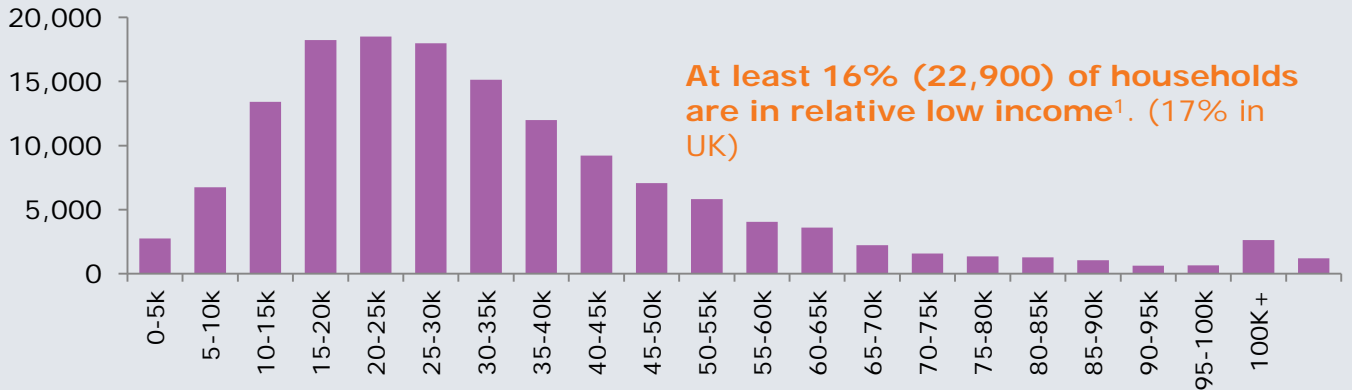


# Cheshire West and Chester Council Household Income 2017



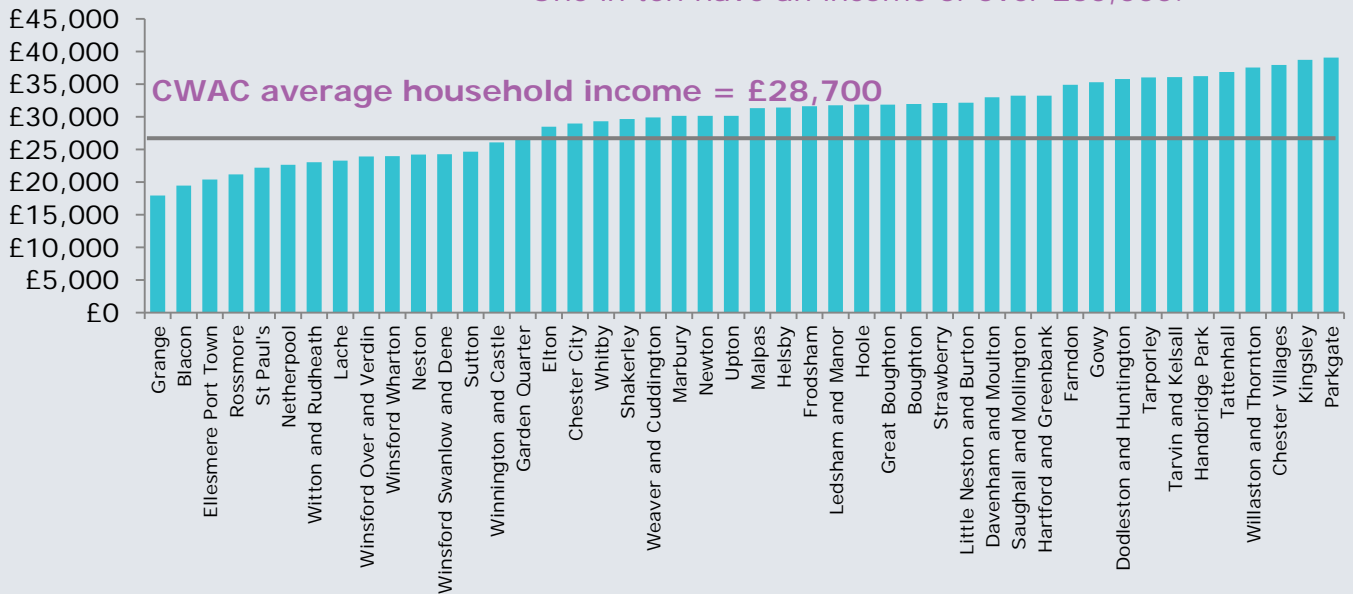
In 2017, the **average (median) household income is £28,700**.  
(higher than the UK (£27,600)).

**Relative low income = below 60% of average national income = below £16,500**



**A quarter** of households have an income of **less than £18,700**.

One in ten have an income of over £60,000.



In Grange ward, average household income is £18,000, a quarter of households have an income of less than £12,100.

At least 5% of households in every ward are in relative low income¹.

1. Income data is in 5k bands. 16% of households have an income below £15,000.
