# LA Primary School Places Scorecard for Cheshire West and Chester

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## Introduction

This document presents school places figures for Cheshire West and Chester covering quantity of places available, forecast accuracy of pupil projections, places allocated by preference, new places allocated by school quality and cost per place. It is intended to provide a downloadable, printable document of figures for individual Local Authorities as an alternative to our online dashboard (available [here](#)).

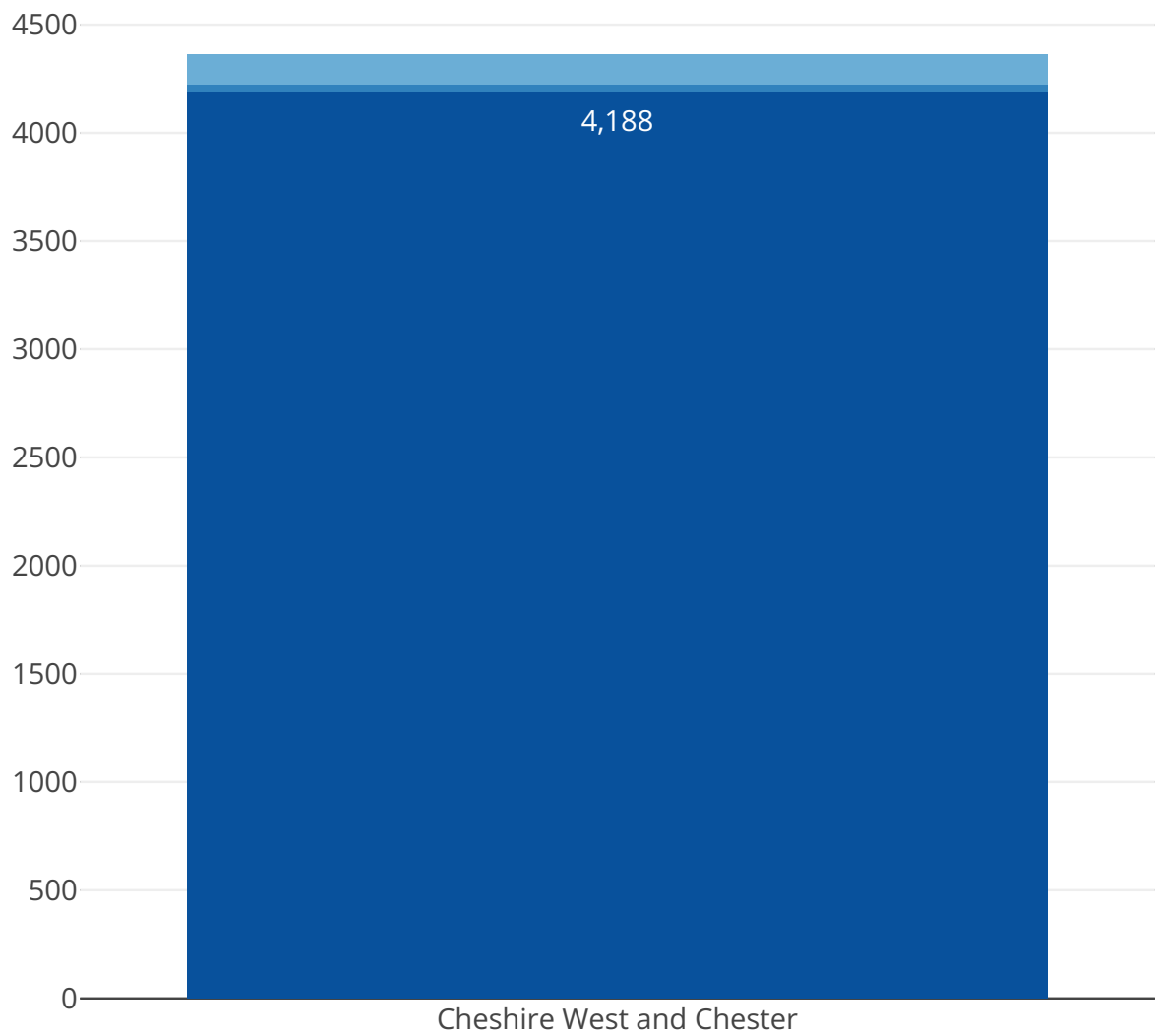

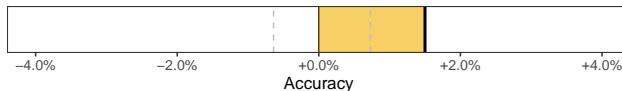
## Forecast Accuracy

### Forecast accuracy of pupil projections for 2021/22, made one year and three years previously

The shaded area in each chart ending at the thick vertical line shows the forecasting accuracy for Cheshire West and Chester. The starting point is 0, an accurate score, indicated by a thin vertical line. A shaded area to the right of 0 indicates an overestimate, a shaded area to the left of 0 indicates an underestimate. The grey dashed lines show the 25th and 75th percentile score for all local authorities.

#### One year ahead: +1.5%

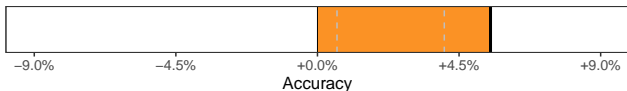

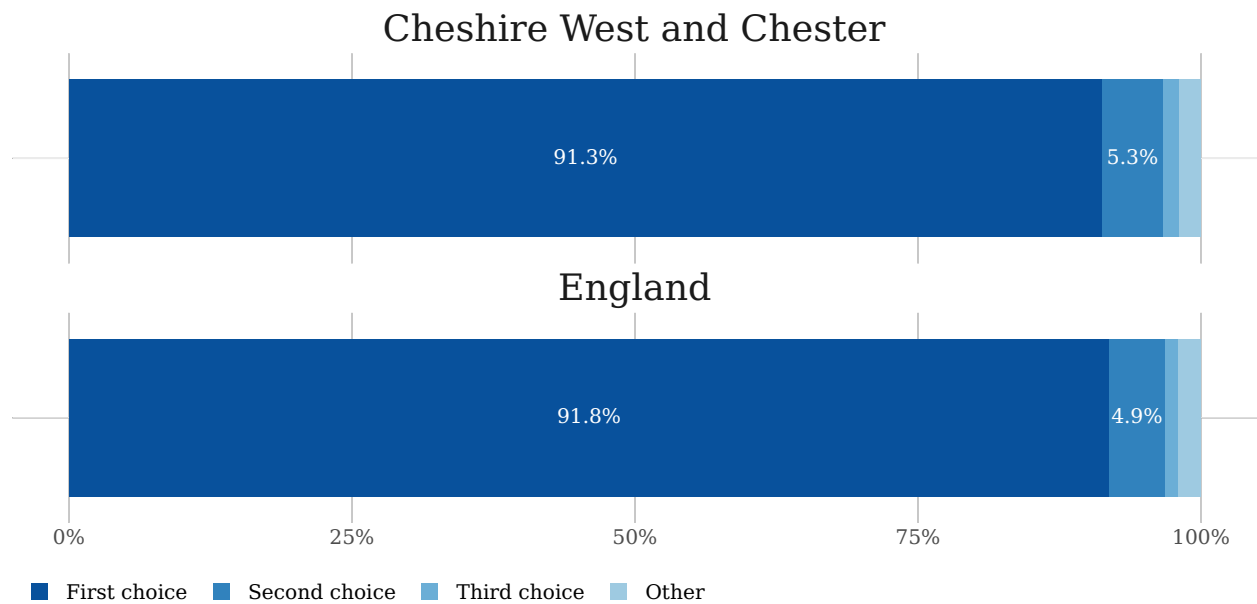
Proportion of applicants who received an offer of one of their top three preference schools for September 2021 entry

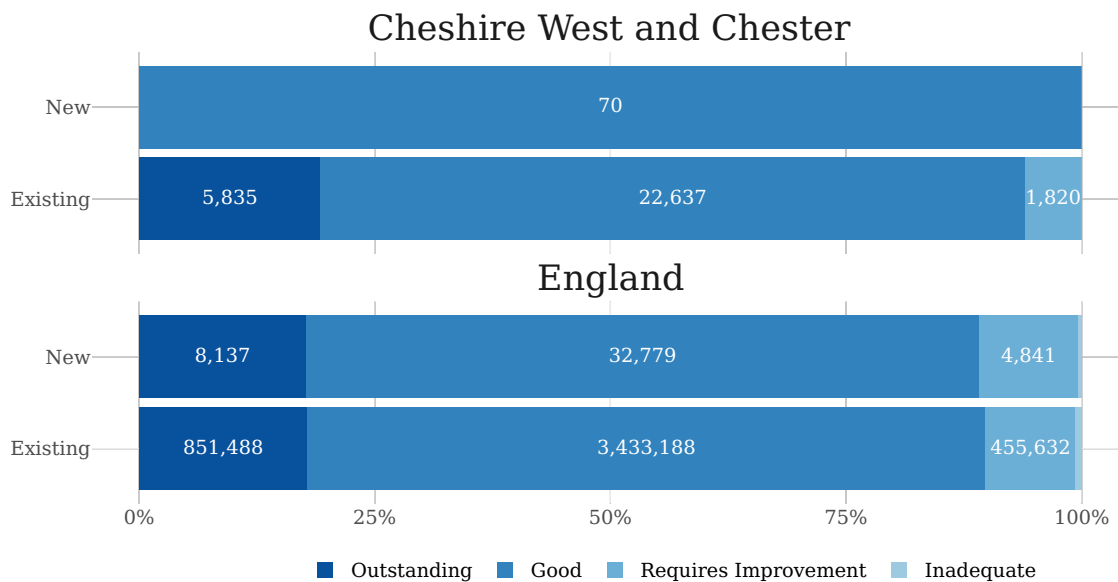

Quality of places created between 2018/19 and 2020/21, based on Ofsted:

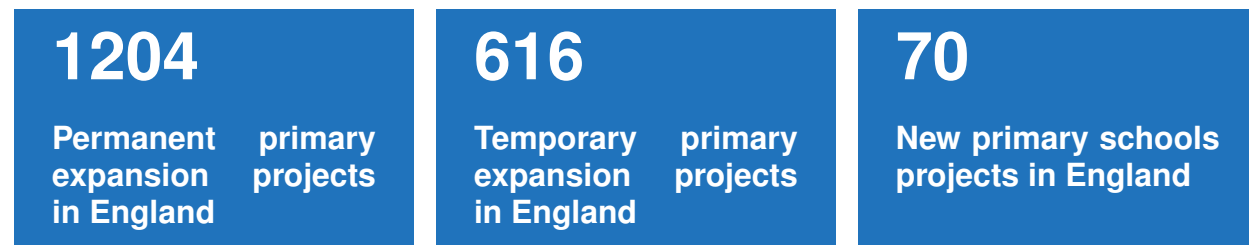
