

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
(Chester 10k)
(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order in accordance with the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect will be to prohibit vehicular traffic on roads in the City of Chester and the Parishes of Bache, Upton, Mollington and Saughall, to enable the Chester 10k to take place on Sunday 18th July 2021

The Order will close the following roads at **4.30am** for an anticipated duration of 9 hours

Northgate Street – Canal Street to Eastgate Street
St Werburgh Street – Northgate Street to Eastgate Street
Eastgate Street – Foregate Street to Northgate Street
Foregate Street – Eastgate Street to St John Street
St John Street – Foregate Street to Little St John Street
Hunter Street – from a point approximately 35m east from the junction of St Martins Way to Northgate Street

The Order will close the following roads at **7.15am** for an anticipated duration of 4½hours.

A540 Parkgate Road – A5480 Countess Way to A494 (West bound off slip road)
Old Parkgate Road, Mollington- A540 Parkgate Road to Townfield Lane
Townfield Lane – Well Lane to A540 Parkgate Road

The Order will close the following roads at **7.15am** for an anticipated duration of 3^¼ hours:

Stadium Way – A548 Sealand Road to Saughall Road
Saughall Road – Cheyney Road to A5480 Deva Link

The Order will close the following roads at **7:30am** for an anticipated duration of 3hours:

A548 New Crane Street – Nuns Road / City Walls Road to Sealand Road
A548 Sealand Road – New Crane Street to Stadium Way

The Order will close the following roads at **7:30am** for an anticipated duration of 4½hours:

A5480 Deva Link - Saughall Road to A540 Parkgate Road
A5480 Countess Way – A540 Parkgate Road to Countess Court
A540 Parkgate Road – A5480 Countess Way to A5116 Liverpool Road
Blacon Avenue - A point immediately east of West Cheshire Custody Facility to A540 Parkgate Road
Abbots Park – Abbots Knoll to A540 Parkgate Road

The Order will close the following roads at **7.30am** for an anticipated duration of 5 hours:

Raymond Street – Wharf View (South View Road end) to Bouverie Street
Canal Street – Raymond Street to Northgate Street
Bouverie Street – Raymond Street to Cheyney Road
Cheyney Road – A540 Parkgate to Saughall Road
Walpole Street - Parkgate Road to Bouverie Street
Garden Lane – Cheyney Road to Canal Street

The Order will also:

Prohibit waiting, loading and unloading on Sunday 18th July 2021 at **4.30am** for a maximum duration of 9 hours on:

Upper Northgate Street/Northgate Street between Canal Street and St Werburgh Street.
St Werburgh Street for its entire length (including the suspension of Disabled parking)
Eastgate Street between St Werburgh Street to Northgate Street

Prohibit waiting at **5.00am** for a maximum duration of 7 hours on Garden Lane (west side) - from a point 5 metres south of the party wall of No's 51/53 Garden Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction

All of the parking restrictions above, in this Order apply to the holders of Blue Badges, Residents Permits and for persons wishing to make deliveries
