

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(A51 TARVIN ROAD/HOLME STREET, CHRISTLETON AND TARVIN)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
2. The Order specified in Schedule 2 to the Order is hereby revoked.
3. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any Regulations or Orders made or having effect as if made under the Act or by any other enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th day of August 2021 and may be cited as “The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (A51 Tarvin Road/Holme Street, Christleton and Tarvin) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021”.

**Schedule 1
(50 mph Speed Limit)**

A51 Tarvin Road/Holme Street, Christleton to Tarvin, from a point 153 metres west of its junction with Stamford Lane to a point 195 metres east of the easterly kerb line of B5132 Barrow Lane, a distance of approximately 1500 metres.

**Schedule 2
(Revocation)**

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Tarvin Road, Stamford Heath)
(50mph speed limit) Order 2016
