

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS**

Notice is hereby given that on the 10 August 2021 Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council made the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into operation on 13 August 2021.

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(A51 TARVIN ROAD/HOLME STREET, CHRISTLETON AND TARVIN)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 50 mph speed limit on A51 Tarvin Road/Holme Street, Christleton to Tarvin from a point 53 metres west of the westerly kerb line of B5132 Barrow Lane to a point 195 metres east of the easterly kerb line of B5132 Barrow Lane, a distance of approximately 260 metres.

The Order will also consolidate existing speed limits.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or to any provision contained in it, on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instruments made under it may have not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from 10 August 2021 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
