

**THE CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(LITTLE NESTON WEST) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018**

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd March 2018 and may be cited as "The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Little Neston West) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018".

**SCHEDULE 1
(20mph Speed Limit)**

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

The entire lengths of Steeple Court, Eldon Terrace, Church Lane, Beechways Drive, Allans Meadow, Allans Close, Grasmere Road, Flint Drive, Flint Close, Flint Meadow, Meadow Close, Thirlmere Road, Henley Road, Sutton Avenue, Henley Close, Arden Drive, West Drive, Wellesbourne Close, The Dale, Stratford Road, Leamington Close, Hampton Crescent, Hampton Close, Coniston Road, Avon Close, Kenilworth Road, Homecrofts, Warwick Close, Merton Close, Somerville Close, Cross Lane, Riverside Walk, Sandon Crescent, Quayside.

Burton Road between its junction with Eldon Terrace and its junction with Allans Meadow.

West Vale between its junction with Grasmere Road to its junction with Thirlmere Road.
