

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER**

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council propose to make the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(CLYDESDALE AND WYEDAILE AREA, WHITBY)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022**

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the following lengths of road:

- Clydesdale (both sides) - (i) from its junction with Deeside for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction; and (ii) from its junction with Park Drive for a distance of 20 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- Deeside (north-east side) - (i) from a point 15.5 metres north-west of the centre-line of Wyedale to a point 14 metres south-east of the centre line of Wyedale; and (ii) from a point 19 metres north-west of the centre line of Clydesdale to a point 17 metres south-east of the centre-line of Clydesdale.
- Eskdale (both sides) - from its junction with Wyedale for a distance of 10 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- Park Drive (south-west side) - (i) from a point 16 metres north-west of the centre-line of Wyedale to a point 21 south-east of the centre-line of Wyedale; and (ii) from a point 28 metres north-west of the centre-line of Clydesdale to a point 24 metres south-east of the centre-line of Clydesdale.
- Wyedale (both sides) - from its junction with Deeside for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- Wyedale (north-west side) - (i) from a point 15 metres south-west of the centre-line of Eskdale to a point 25 metres north-east of the centre-line of Eskdale; and (ii) from its junction with Park Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- Wyedale (south-east side) - from its junction with Park Drive for a distance of 17 metres in a south-westerly direction.

The Order will also prohibit stopping between 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday on the existing School Keep Clear markings on Clydesdale and Wyedale.

Full details are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the extents of the proposal, may be viewed in the Public Notices section of the Council's website, or at, Ellesmere Port Library, Civic Way, Ellesmere Port, Cheshire, CH65 0BG between the hours of 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
