The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council
(Off-Street Parking Places, Former Vale Royal and Rural Area) (Church Street,
Kelsall Variation) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make the above-named Order in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will introduce a two-hour maximum stay from Monday to Friday, between 9am and 6pm and Saturday, between 9am and 1pm. No maximum stay will apply on Sundays. Blue badge holders will be permitted to park for up to four hours in marked disabled persons' bays on the same days and times.

Parking permits will be made available for local residents and businesses. Details of this are available from Kelsall Parish Council.

Full details are in the draft Order, which may be viewed in the Public Notices section of the Council's website, at Cheshire West and Chester HQ, 58 Nicholas Street, Chester, CH1 2NP, or at the Parish Council notice board at Church Street, Kelsall

All objections and other representations relating to the Order must be made in writing to the undersigned by 7 October 2022 and objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. Any representations relating to the Order should specify the title of the Order and may become available for public inspection.
