Northwich Krazy Races

(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on following roads in Northwich to enable the Northwich Krazy Races to be carried out by organiser.

The Order will come into force on Sunday 26 June 2022 as detailed below

The following lengths of road will be closed from 4.01am to 10pm

Castle Street (From Ryders Street to A533 Chester Way)

Chester Way (From London Road to Castle Street)

A533 Castle Street (From Chester Way to Winnington Hill)

Alternative routes for traffic

Traffic diverted from Castle Street should proceed via A559, B5153, Burrows Hill, Winnington Avenue and Winnington Lane.

Diverted traffic from Chester Way should proceed via A533 Kingsmead, A556, School Lane, A559 to Northwich

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
