Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

(MBNA Chester Marathon)

(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make an Order in accordance with the provisions of Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and with the consent of Wrexham County Borough Council. The effect will be to prohibit and restrict vehicular traffic on roads in the City of Chester, the Parishes of Claverton, Eccleston, Eaton, Pulford, Farndon, Churton by Farndon, Churton by Aldford, Aldford, Buerton, Huntington and Christleton and the Communities of Rossett and Holt to enable the MBNA Chester Marathon to take place on Sunday 2nd October 2022.

The Order will close the following road from 7am on Saturday 1 October to 8pm on Sunday 2 October:

Castle Drive – Entrance to Little Roodee Car Park to Old Dee Bridge

The Order will:

Make Watergate Street become one-way in an Eastbound direction at its junction between Chester Racecourse and St Martins Way/Nicholas Street at 7.30am for an anticipated duration of 3 hours and 15 minutes.

Prohibit the Left Turn on to New Crane Street from Nuns Road and the Right Turn from City Walls Road at 7.30am for an anticipated duration of 3 hours and 15 minutes.

(Nuns Road – into New Crane Street)

(City Walls Road – into New Crane Street)

Prohibit entry onto the B5130 Sandy Lane at its junction with the A51 Christleton Road at 8am for an anticipated duration of 8 hours.

Close the following roads from 8.50am and then again from 10am for an anticipated duration of 30 minutes on each occasion.

New Crane Street (from Nuns Road to South view Road)

Close the following roads at 7.30am for an anticipated duration of 3 hours and 30 minutes.

South View Road – whole length (New Crane Street to Raymond Street)

Raymond Street – South View Road to Canal Street

Canal Street – whole length (Raymond Street to Upper Northgate Street)

Northgate Street – whole length (Upper Northgate Street to Eastgate Street)

Upper Northgate Street – The Northgate to George Street

Water Tower Street – Canning Street to Northgate Street

Princess Street - Northgate Street to Hunters Walk

St Werburgh Street – whole length (Northgate Street to Eastgate Street)

Eastgate Street – whole length (Foregate Street to Northgate Street)

St John Street – whole length (Foregate Street to Little St John Street)

Foregate Street – Eastgate Street to St John Street

Lower Bridge Street – whole length (Pepper Street to Old Dee Bridge)

Grosvenor Street – Grosvenor Roundabout to Pepper Street

Pepper Street – Bridge Street to Little St John Street

Vicars Lane – Little St John Street to Union Street

Love Street - whole length (Foregate Street to A5268 Vicar's Lane)

A5268 Union Street - whole length Vicars Lane to Grosvenor Park Road

A5268 Grosvenor Park Road - Union Street to A51 The Bars

Close the following roads at 7.30am for an anticipated duration of 8 hours.

Old Dee Bridge – Lower Bridge Street to Handbridge

Handbridge – Old Dee Bridge to Queens Park Road

Close the following roads at 8am for an anticipated duration of 2 hours

Handbridge and Overleigh Road – Queens Park Road to the main pedestrian entrance to St Mary without the Walls

Prohibit vehicular traffic from:

turning right from Foregate Street into Love Street and turning left from Forest Street into Love Street-
from 8am for an anticipated duration of 2 hours and 30 minutes.

Close the slip road from A51 Boughton to A5268 Grosvenor Park Road from 8.30am for an
anticipated duration of 8 hours

Close the following roads at 8am for an anticipated duration of 4 hours:

Eaton Road – whole length (Handbridge to Hill Road)

Rake Lane/Hill Road – Paddock Road to B5445 Wrexham Road

Straight Mile – B5445 Wrexham Road to Old Lane

Old Lane – whole length (Straight Mile to B5445 Wrexham Road)

B5445 Wrexham Road – A483 Wrexham Road to County Boundary

B5445 Chester Road – County Boundary to Darland Lane

Darland Lane – whole length (Chester Road to Gamford Lane)

Gamford Lane – whole length (Darland Lane to Rossett Road)

Close the following roads at 8.30am for an anticipated duration of 7 hours and 15 minutes.

Dee Lane – whole length (A51 Boughton to Grosvenor ParkTerrace)

Grosvenor Park Terrace – whole length (Dee Lane to The Groves)

The Groves – whole length (Grosvenor Park Terrace to the bollards at the start of the pedestrianised
area and Souters Lane South west to the bollards at the start of the pedestrianised area)

Souters Lane – whole length (Pepper Street to The Groves)

Close the following roads at 11am for an anticipated duration of 5 hours.

Lower Bridge Street – Castle Street to Old Dee Bridge.

Close the following roads at 9am for an anticipated duration of 5 hours:

B5102 Rossett Road – whole length (Chapel Lane to Borrass Road)

Borras Road – whole length (Rossett Road to Hosley Lane)
Buck Road – whole length (Borras Road to Commonwood Road)
Commonwood Road – whole length (Shepherds Road to Borras Road)
B5102 Borras Road – whole length (Rossett Road to Frog Lane)
B5102 Frog Lane – whole length (Borras Road to Cross Street)
Cross Street – whole length (Frog Lane to Ashley Court)
Green Street – whole length (Ashley Court to Bridge Street)
Bridge Street – Quakers Way to County Boundary

Close the following roads at 9.45am for an anticipated duration of 5 hours:

High Street, Farndon – Holt/Farndon Bridge to Church Street
Churton Road/Chester Road, Farndon/Churton – the Barnston Monument to B5130
Sibbersfield Lane
Stannage Lane, Churton – whole length
B5130 Chester Road – New Lane, Churton to School Lane, Aldford
School Lane/Mill Lane/Church Lane, Aldford – whole length

Close the following roads at 9.30am for an anticipated duration of 2 hours:

B5130 Chester Road – Chapel Lane, Aldford to Sandy Lane, Huntington
B5130 Chester Road – Sandy Lane, Huntington to Caldly Valley Road, Huntington..

Close the following road at 10.30am for an anticipated duration of 2 hours

B5130 Chester Road – School Lane, Aldford to Chapel Lane, Aldford
B5130 Chester Road – New Lane, Churton to Pump Lane, Churton
Hob Lane, Churton – B5130 Chester Road to Stannage Lane, Churton

Close the following road at 12noon for an anticipated duration of 4 hours:

B5130 Chester Road – Chapel Lane, Aldford to Caldly Valley Road, Huntington. (To those
requiring access/egress to/from land or premises along this length of road.
Access/egress will only be permitted for traffic travelling in a north to south direction)

The Order will also:

Introduce a temporary one-way restriction at 9.30am for an anticipated duration of 5 hours and 15 minutes on Churton Road from the Barnston Monument, Farndon to its junction with High Street, Farndon. Traffic will only be permitted to travel in a north to south direction.

Introduce a temporary one-way restriction at 9.30am for an anticipated duration of 7 hours and 30 minutes on B5130 Sandy Lane/Dee Banks/Chester Road from its junction with A51 Boughton to its junction with Sandy Lane, Huntington. Traffic will only be permitted to travel in a north to south direction.

Close the gap in the central reservation of A51 Boughton at its junction with Hoole Lane at 9.30am for an anticipated duration of 6 hours and 30 minutes.

The Order will also:

Prohibit waiting from 5pm on Saturday 1 October for an anticipated duration of 22 hours on the following lengths of road:

Churton Road, Farndon (east side) – Barnston Monument to High Street

Cross Street, Holt (both sides) – B5102 The Cross to Green Street

Green Street, Holt (both sides) – Cross Street to Bridge Street

B5130 Sandy Lane, Boughton (both sides) – The Mount to Dee Fords Avenue

B5130 Chester Road, Huntington (both sides) – Keristal Avenue to Sandy Lane
(excluding 100metres on west side from the end of the DYL opposite Keristal Av)

Church Lane, Aldford (both sides) B5130 Chester Road to Middle Lane

South View Road (north side) – 18 metres east of New Crane Street to 10 metres west of Charlotte Street

South View Road (north side) – 15 metres east of Charlotte Street to 12 metres west of Whipcord Lane

Grosvenor Park Road (both sides including residents parking bays) - A51 The Bars to Bath Street

The Groves from Souters Lane to the pedestrianized area leading to Dee Bridge

Prohibit waiting from 11pm on Saturday 1 October for an anticipated duration of 16 hours on the following lengths of road:

Dee Banks/Chester Road (west side) from a point 100metres on west side from the end of the DYL opposite Keristal Av)

Prohibit waiting from 6am for an anticipated duration of 7 hours and 30 minutes on the following lengths of road:

St Werburgh Street (south side) - from a point 12 metres west of the centre line of Godstall Lane to a point 15 metres east of the centre line of Godstall Lane.

Northgate Street (both sides) from Upper Northgate Street to St Werburgh Street.

Suspend the no motor vehicles except for access restriction on Cuppin Street at 8.30am for an duration of 2 hours and 30 minutes.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR TRAFFIC

Traffic diverted from Sealand Road and New Crane Street should proceed via Deva Link and Parkgate Road.

Traffic diverted from B5445 Wrexham Road should proceed via A483 Wrexham Road, B5102 Llay Road and B5445 Chester Road

Southbound traffic diverted from B5130 Chester Road should proceed via Sandy Lane and Chapel Lane to Aldford, and via the A5115 Whitchurch Road/Christleton Road, A41 Whitchurch Road, A534 Broxton Road/Barton Road and B5130 Sibbersfield Lane to Farndon. Northbound traffic should proceed via the B5130 Sibberfield Lane to Churton (access limited) , and via the A534 Barton Road/Broxton Road, A41 Whitchurch Road and A5115 Whitchurch Road/Christleton Road to Chester.

NB There will be no access to Aldford between 10.30am and 12 noon.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
