Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic as identified in Chester because of the likelihood of danger to the public for Chester Long Distance Sculls on Sunday 25 September 2022.

The notice will close the following length of roads from 6.30am-7pm on Sunday 25 September 2022.

Souters Lane Full length.

The Groves between Lower Bridge Street and a point 140m east of Souters Lane

The notice will also suspend parking, loading and unloading between 6.30am and 5pm on Sunday 25 September 2022.

The Groves between Lower Bridge Street and a point 140m east of Souters Lane

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
