

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council

Proposal to enlarge, by expansion, Blacon High School.

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Blacon High School, Melbourne Road, Chester, CH1 5JH, from 1 September 2020.

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council propose to expand Blacon High School in order to fulfil it's duty to provide enough school places in the area.

The current capacity of the school is 600 and the proposed expansion would provide 150 additional places across the year groups 7 to 11. The change is proposed to take effect from 1 September 2020.
